BA Rising Offering Small Business Economic Recovery Microgrant

Broken Arrow, OK – May 7, 2020 – The Broken Arrow Economic Development Corporation (BAEDC) partnered with the Broken Arrow Chamber of Commerce and City of Broken Arrow to offer a Small Business Economic Recovery Microgrant in an effort to assist the businesses who have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We believe it is vital to provide this grant now as access to restart expenses like PPE expenditures were determined as a major need for our BA businesses through our research with BA Rising efforts, which included virtual roundtables and surveys," said Jennifer Conway, President and CEO of the Broken Arrow Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development Corporation.

The City Council voted unanimously to dedicate \$100,000 of economic development funding to the BA Rising Microgrant program. Jennifer Conway explained city funds would be combined with donations from the BAEDC and Chamber. Unused grant dollars would be returned to the city.
